1. **Why** was the boy wearing pajamas at the beginning of the story? (because he was going to go to sleep - 2)
2. **When** did the frog escape from the jar? (at night, when the boy and dog were sleeping - 2)
3. **Where** did the dog and the boy sleep? (in the bed - 3)
4. **When** did the boy realize that the frog had escaped? (when he woke up, in the morning - 1)
5. **Where** did the dog stick his head? (in the jar - 2)
6. **Who** fell out of the window? (the dog - 1)
7. **What** broke when the dog fell out of the window? (the jar - 3)
8. **What** happened when the boy looked in the hole in the ground? (a mole came out and bit his nose - 3)
9. **Who** chased the dog? (the bees - 4)
10. **Why** did the bees chase the dog? (because the dog was barking at them/ bothering them - 3)
11. **What** came out of the large hole in the tree? (an owl - 2)
12. **What** happened when the boy climbed on top of the rock? (the boy grabbed the deer's antlers / the deer picked him up on his head - 1)
13. **Who** fell off of the cliff? Point to two. (the boy and the dog – 1, 4)
14. **Where** did the dog and the boy land when they fell off the cliff? (in the water - 4)
15. **What** happened after the boy fell in the water? (the boy heard something - 4)
16. **What** did the boy and the dog find behind the log? (a frog family - 1)
17. **When** did the boy find his frog? (at the end of the story; after he fell in the water; when he heard the frogs behind the log - 2)
18. **Why** did the big frog not go home with the boy? (because he wants to be with his family - 3)

[Where did the dog and the boy sleep? (in the bed)]
4. ¿Cuándo se dio cuenta el niño que la rana se escapó? (en la mañana cuando el niño despertó)
[When did the boy realize that the frog had escaped? (when he woke up in the morning)]
5. ¿Dónde metió la cabeza el perro? (en el jarro) [Where did the dog stick his head? (in the jar)]

[What broke when the dog fell out of the window? (the jar)]

[What happened when the boy looked in the hole in the ground? (a mole came out and bit his nose)]
9. ¿Quién persiguió al perro? (las abejas) [Who chased the dog? (the bees)]
10. ¿Por qué las abejas persiguieron al perro? (porque las estuvo ladrando/molestando)
[Why did the bees chase the dog? (because the dog was barking at them/bothering them)]

deer's antlers/the deer picked him up on his head)]
13. ¿Quiénes se cayeron del precipicio? Enseña dos. (el niño y el perro)
[Who fell off the cliff? Point to two. (the boy and the dog)]
14. ¿En dónde cayeron el perro y el niño cuando se cayeron del precipicio? (en el agua)
[Where did the dog and boy land when they fell off the cliff? (in the water)]
15. ¿Qué pasó después que el niño se cayó al agua? (el niño escuchó algo)
[What happened after the boy fell into the water? (the boy heard something)]
16. ¿Qué encontraron el niño y el perro atrás del tronco del árbol? (una familia de ranas)
[What did the boy and the dog find behind the log? (a frog family)]
17. ¿Cuándo encontró el niño a su rana? (al final del cuento, después que se cayó al agua, cuando
escucho las ranas en el tronco) [When did the boy find his frog? (At the end of the story, after he fell in the
water, when he heard the frogs behind the log.)]
18. ¿Por qué la rana grande no regresó a la casa con el niño? (porque ya tiene una familia)
[Why did the big frog not go home with the boy? (because he now has a family.)]

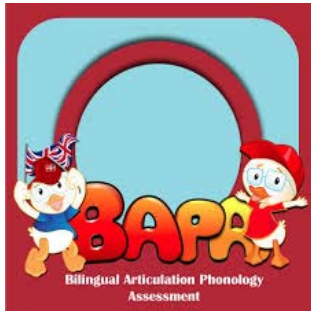

¿Cómo se sintió el niño cuando encontró a su rana? (feliz, aliviado) [How did the boy feel when he found his frog? (happy, relieved)]

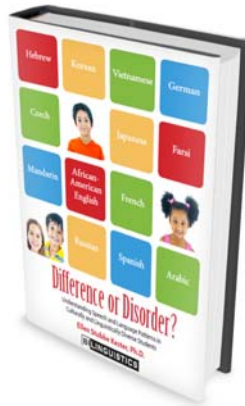

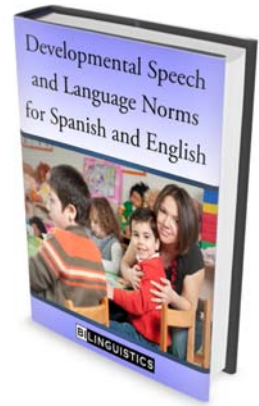
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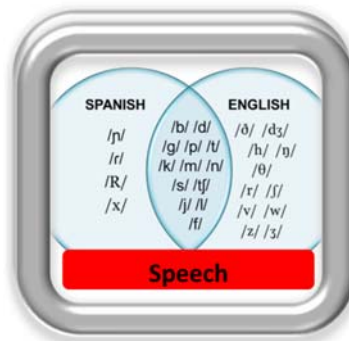
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
