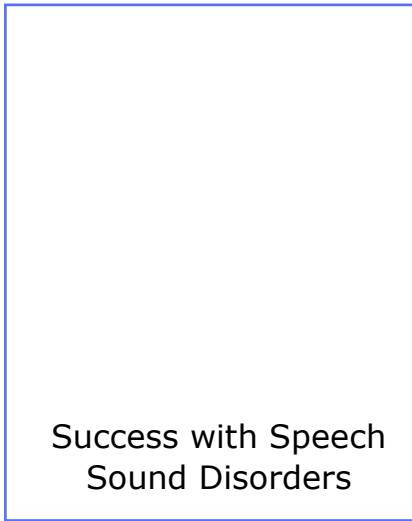
GARS-3
