

Assurances

- The ARD committee assures that removal of students with disabilities from the general educational environment occurs only if the nature or severity of the disability is such that education in regular classes with the use of supplementary aids and services cannot be achieved satisfactorily.
- The ARD committee assures that each student with a disability participates in nonacademic and extracurricular services and activities, including meals and recess periods, with non-disabled students to the maximum extent appropriate to the needs of that student.
- The ARD committee assures that to the maximum extent appropriate, students with disabilities are educated with students who are non-disabled.

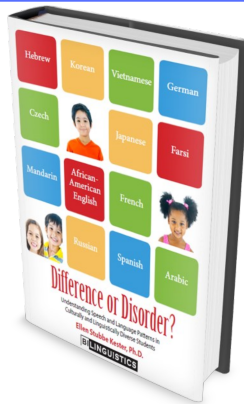
Garantías

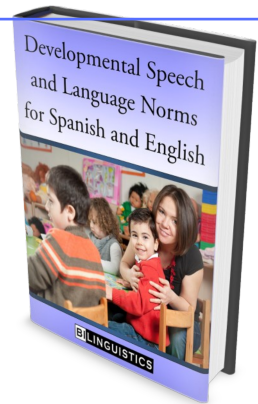
