
Quick Informal Vision Screener


When a child comes for an evaluation who has not yet had a vision screening, you can use this informal vision screening to get an indication about whether vision is adequate for the purposes of testing. Give strip of shapes to student. Hold the other shapes up one at a time at 6 or 10 feet to see if they can identify the correct shape on their strip.
